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## 1. Infopoint

If you have any questions or concerns, you are welcome to contact the clothes counter during opening hours or Barbara Matti (Volunteers, +41 79 345 86 19) directly.

## 2. Your commitment

You will receive your assignment confirmation with all the details before you arrive. Please arrive at the meeting point approx. 5 minutes before your first assignment.

Find out about travelling to Gstaad in good time so that you are ready on time on the day of your assignment.

Cancellations in the event of illness, accident, etc. must be notified in good time (Barbara Matti, barbara.matti@beachgstaad.ch, +41 79 345 86 19). In the event of cancellation, we would be delighted if you could help us find a replacement.

## 3. Volunteer- Accreditation

Your personal volunteer accreditation (wristband) will be handed in together with your clothes.

## 4. Volunteer clothing

### Equipment

For all volunteers there are: 2 T-shirts, hoodie, rain jacket, cap

- T-shirt: you can keep the anniversary edition
- Hoodie: return it or if you are back in 2026 - keep it and wear it again bring along
- Rain jacket: must be returned
- Cap: you can keep it

#### → Info court staff:

- Ballkids and Sandrecheler will receive official shorts. We ask the other volunteers to bring their own black trousers.
- In cold weather, you can wear a black long-sleeved shirt under your T-shirt and black long pants / thermal underwear or leggings under your shorts. Please bring your own trainers with socks and flip-flops, preferably in a rucksack labelled with your name!
- It is advisable for sand cyclists to wear cycling gloves.
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#### → Info access control:

- Volunteers working at the entrance control must bring their own black / dark blue shorts or trousers and closed shoes

#### → Info Gastro Areal Centre Court:

- Please bring closed shoes or trainers - no flip-flops.

→ **Info VIP-Bar:**

- Please bring your own blue trousers (including jeans) - no hot pants. We recommend comfortable shoes (e.g. ballerinas). No flip-flops may be worn while working! Sunglasses that allow the eyes to be clearly visible are permitted.

→ **Info VIP-Skylounge:**

- Please bring your own black trousers - no hot pants. We recommend comfortable shoes (e.g. ballerinas). No flip-flops may be worn while working! Sunglasses that allow the eyes to be clearly visible are permitted.

→ **Construction info:**

- Please bring work clothes (adapted to the weather), good shoes and work gloves.

→ **Info Cleaning / Provide side courts:**

- Please bring trainers and work gloves.

→ **Info Mus Musculus:**

- Please bring trainers and shower gear.

## 5. Accommodation

### Room allocation

We will inform you of the definitive room allocation by e-mail shortly before the tournament.

### Accommodation

#### **Sport Lodge Haus A & B, Gstaad (at the sports centre, within walking distance):**

- Please bring your own towelling.
- Door code: The door is open from 7.00 - 20.00h, after that a door code applies (follows with the room information).
- Check-in from 14.00 hrs
- Check-out: The rooms must be swept clean by 9.00 am on Sunday, 06.07.2025 at the latest. Strip beds and put used bed linen in the linen trolley in the entrance. Empty rubbish bins and dispose of PET.

#### **Chalet Jacqueline, Gstaad (near the sports centre, within walking distance):**

- Please bring your own towelling.
- A door code applies to the entrance door (follows with the room information).
- Check-in from 10.00 am
- Check-out: The rooms must be swept clean by 9.00 am on Sunday, 06.07.2025 at the latest. Strip beds and put used bed linen in the linen trolley in the entrance. Empty rubbish bins and dispose of PET.

#### **Le Petit Relais, Saanenmöser (public transport, car - approx. 15 minutes) :**

- Check-in between 16.00 - 19.00 (luggage can also be deposited earlier)
- Check-out until 11.00 am
- Public transport can be used free of charge with the guest card available at reception.

### Luggage storage

Luggage can be stored in the basement of the Sport Lodge, House A (near the sports centre) in the volunteers' lounge until departure. We accept no liability for valuables!

## Meal vouchers

The familiar meal vouchers will be replaced by wristbands (handed in at the clothes counter) with a credit of food vouchers and a deposit (don't forget to load this deposit back onto your card at the return point). These can be used to purchase meals in the Coop Restaurant and at the Bschüssig stand in the Beach Village

## Drinks

Drinks can also be purchased with the credit on the wristband at the volunteer tent on the site and at the side courts (1 drink per day of work). In addition, each volunteer will receive a water bottle (please write to us) to fill up.

## 7. Depot

### Valuables

Valuables, rucksacks and personal items can be handed in and collected during opening hours at the clothes counter in the curling hall (near the sports centre).

### Bicycle and moped car park

The official bicycle and moped car park is located behind the Coop car park just after the subway on the left (gravel area).

Bicycles parked at the Coop or in the Centre Court area will be removed by the police.

## 8. Insurance

By registering as a volunteer, you accept that participation is at your own responsibility and risk and release the organiser and its auxiliary persons from all liability claims, insofar as this is legally permissible.

You must have your own accident, health and personal liability insurance. You are insured by the organiser against third-party liability claims that you may cause during your assignment.

Your wristband gives you access to the volunteer stand (sector H) during your days of work and breaks. All other stands are closed to volunteers

### Common room

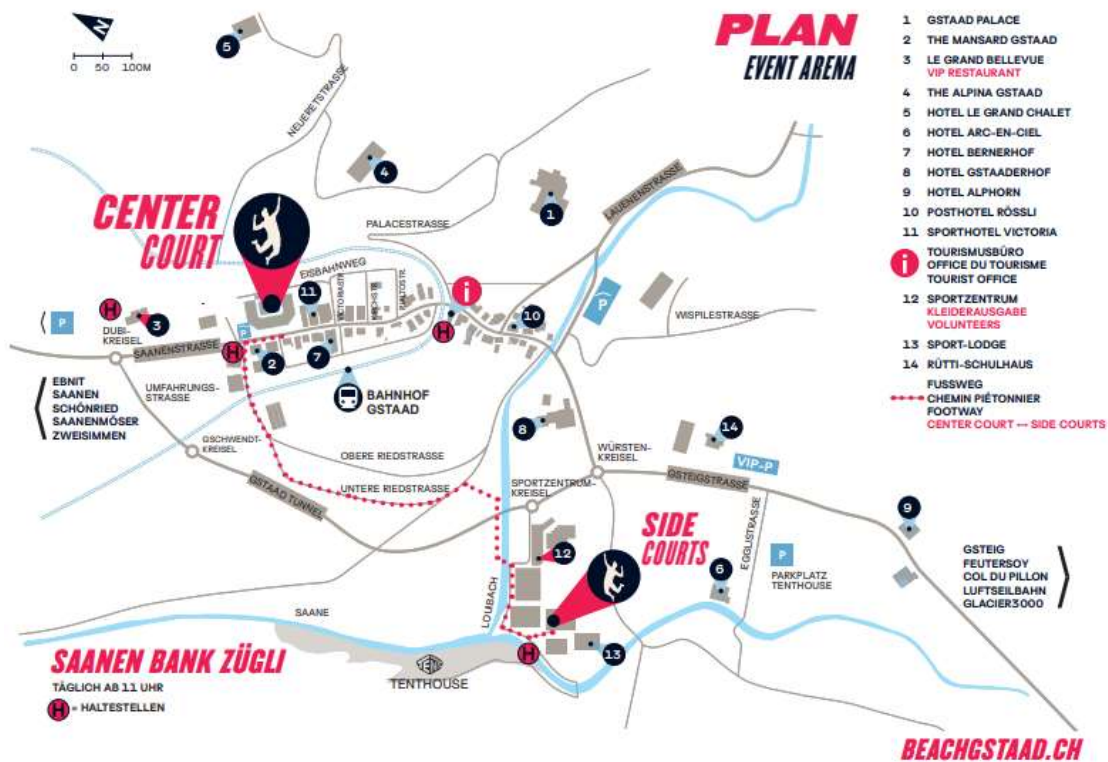
The lounge for the volunteers is located in the basement of the Sport Lodge, House A (next to the sports centre).
